REDEVELOPMENT WORKS UPDATE – ENTRANCE

There has been a change to the way patrons access the Centre in order for work on the new café and entrance area to be carried out.

The main entrance to the Ballarat Aquatic Centre will close from Monday 31 May and entry will be via the doors at the west side of the building opposite the main car park.

All visitors to the Centre will be required to enter through the west entry and proceed to the reception desk before moving to the various activities within the centre. The main entrance is expected to re-open to the public late July.

Children's Centre: Special arrangements have been put in place for entry to the crèche. Parents and carers, who are bringing children to crèche, need to enter the Centre via the crèche outdoor gate and through the glass door off the outdoor play area. They will then need to exit the crèche in the same way and proceed through the temporary entrance to reception to use Centre facilities and to arrange payment for their crèche visit. Receipts will need to be provided when collecting children.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused as a result of the redevelopment and thank patrons for their cooperation and patience. We ask that visitors remain patient as the redevelopment is underway.
